



Church Builder - Tips for Teachers

Using the Software

Do's	Have a go yourself before hand
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Try it out before you show the pupils● Let the children find out for themselves● Refer pupils back to their own reference materials such as pictures and sketches● Encourage pupils to use the help files● Remember to save regularly	
Don'ts	Some will use all the features they can!
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Spend too much time explaining all the features of the software● Restrict pupils use of features - let them play!● Do it for them - set a level of challenge● Panic if their church looks different	
Share your information	Collaborative learning is good!
<p>Remember to allow time for pupils to share what they have discovered and learnt.</p> <p>Plenary time is a great way of not only assessing what has been learnt but also sharing features/ideas and hints.</p> <p>Try asking everyone to contribute just one thing they have learnt on their own and one thing they have learnt from a friend - you will be amazed at the information transfer that happens without you seeing it.</p>
